2 Rome and its Empire

Discuss the subjects **and** characteristics of Roman sculpture with reference to **three** specific examples. (20 marks)

3 Early Christian and Byzantine

Describe and discuss **two** sculptures from the Early Christian period between c.300 and c.800. (20 marks)

4 Romanesque

Identify the characteristic features of Romanesque religious architecture with reference to **three** specific examples. (20 marks)

5 Gothic

Outline the main developments in Gothic religious architecture with reference to **three** specific examples. (20 marks)

6 Medieval

How was the subject of the Madonna and Child represented in the period c.1250–c.1400? Answer with reference to **two** specific examples. (20 marks)

7 15th Century Florence

Describe **two** sculptures produced in Florence by different sculptors which demonstrate the influence of classical style and/or characteristics. (20 marks)

8 15th Century Italy (excluding Florence)

Compare and contrast **two** paintings, each by a different painter working outside Florence. (20 marks)

9 Northern Europe

Discuss the style of **one** painter working in Northern Europe between c.1400 and c.1527. Answer with reference to **two** specific works. (20 marks)

10 High Renaissance in Italy

Identify the principal features of High Renaissance architecture with reference to **two** specific buildings. (20 marks)
