Discuss **three** examples of how sculpture was used to decorate religious buildings during this period **and** consider the relationship between the sculpture and the architecture.

Analyse the Renaissance characteristics of **one** painting, **one** sculpture and **one** building.

Question 6



Discuss how religious purpose was conveyed in three sixteenth-century paintings.

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Analyse **three** sixteenth-century examples of portraiture, each by a different artist. How were ideas of character and identity conveyed? You may choose your examples from painting **and/or** sculpture.

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8 Analyse **three** sixteenth-century religious buildings **and** discuss the relationship between form and function in each.
