Answer one question.

1. The establishment of the Tudor dynasty: the reign of Henry VII, 1485-1509.

- (a) Explain why Henry VII avoided becoming involved in foreign wars. [24]
- (b) To what extent was Henry VII's treatment of the nobility mainly responsible for the establishment of the Tudor dynasty during the period 1485-1509? [36]

2. Religious changes in Wales and England, c. 1500-1559.

- (a) Explain why Henry VIII wanted to become head of the Church in England. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the reign of Edward VI responsible for the most important religious changes in Wales and England in the period 1500-1559? [36]

3. Tudor Rebellions, c. 1536-1554.

- (a) Explain why Kett's rebellion failed. [24]
- (b) To what extent were political grievances mainly responsible for causing the Tudor rebellions in the period 1536-1554? [36]
