1. The reign of James I, 1603-1625.

2. The reign of Charles I, 1625-1637.

- (a) Explain why the Personal Rule of Charles I was unpopular. [24]
- (b) To what extent was religion mainly responsible for the difficulties faced by Charles I in the period 1625-1637? [36]

3. The collapse of the Personal Rule, the Long Parliament and the First Civil War, 1637-1646.

- (a) Explain why Charles I quarrelled with the Scottish Kirk. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the leadership of Parliament mainly responsible for the difficulties faced by Charles I in the period 1637-1646? [36]
