# 1. The reign of James I, 1603-1625.

- (a) Explain why there was a breakdown in relations between James I and Parliament. [24]
- (b) To what extent was James I personally responsible for the unpopularity of the Stuart monarchy by the time of his death in 1625? [36]

## 2. The reign of Charles I, 1625-1637.

- (a) Explain why the Petition of Right was presented to the King. [24]
- (b) To what extent was Charles I personally responsible for the unpopularity of the Stuart monarchy by 1637? [36]

# 3. The collapse of the Personal Rule, the Long Parliament and the First Civil War, 1637-1646.

- (a) Explain why the Short Parliament was summoned. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the collection of Ship Money largely responsible for the problems encountered by Charles I in the period following 1637? [36]
