Answer one question.

1. The establishment of the Tudor dynasty: the reign of Henry VII.

- (a) Explain why Henry VII was able to rule without Parliament for most of his reign. [24]
- (b) To what extent was Henry VII's foreign policy the most important contribution to the establishment of the Tudor dynasty during the period 1485-1509? [36]

2. Religious changes in Wales and England, c. 1500-1558.

- (a) Explain why the monasteries were dissolved in 1536. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the European Reformation the most important factor in bringing about religious change in Wales and England in the period 1500-1558? [36]

3. Tudor Rebellions, c. 1536-1554.

- (a) Explain why Kett's rebellion broke out in 1549. [24]
- (b) To what extent was poor leadership mainly responsible for the failure of Tudor rebellions in the period 1536-1554? [36]
