Answer one question.

1. Society in transition in Wales and England, c. 1880-1914.

- (a) Explain why the Conservatives lost the election in 1906. [24]
- (b) To what extent were the Liberal social reforms the most important development in Wales and England between 1880-1914? [36]

2. British foreign policy, c. 1878-1914.

- (a) Explain why Britain adopted a policy of Splendid Isolation. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the Anglo-French Entente of 1904 the most important event in British foreign policy in the period 1878-1914? [36]

3. Wales and England and the First World War, 1914-1918.

- (*a*) Explain why the first battle of the Somme, 1916, was important during the First World War. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the Home Front mainly responsible for British victory in the First World War, 1914-1918? [36]
