Answer one question.

- (a) Explain why the Thirty Years War broke out in 1618. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the power of the Holy Roman Empire greatly reduced during the Thirty Years War? [36]

2. The rise of Prussia, 1640-1740.

- (a) Explain why Frederick William the Great Elector was an important figure in the rise of Prussia. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the power of the army entirely responsible for the rise of Prussia between 1640 and 1740? [36]

3. Sweden, 1618-1721.

- (a) Explain why Sweden became involved in the Thirty Years War. [24]
- (b) To what extent was Charles XII mainly responsible for the decline of Sweden? [36]
