Answer one question.

1. The establishment of the Tudor dynasty: the reign of Henry VII 1485-1509.

- (a) Explain why Henry VII needed to control the nobility. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the defeat of the pretenders the main reason for the establishment of the Tudor dynasty during the period 1485-1509? [36]

2. Religious changes in Wales and England, c. 1500-1558.

- (a) Explain why religious changes were introduced by the governments in this period. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the Catholic Church mainly responsible for religious change in Wales and England in the period 1500-1558? [36]

3. Tudor Rebellions, c. 1536-1554.

- (a) Explain why the Pilgrimage of Grace, led by Robert Aske, failed. [24]
- (b) To what extent were social and economic grievances mainly responsible for causing the Tudor rebellions in the period 1536-1554? [36]
