1. Society in transition in Wales and England, c. 1880-1914.

- (a) Explain why the Liberal government introduced social reforms between 1906-1914. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the growth of the Labour Party the most important change in Wales and England between 1880-1914? [36]

2. British foreign policy, c. 1878-1914.

- (a) Explain why Britain signed ententes during this period. [24]
- (b) To what extent was Splendid Isolation the main influence on British foreign policy between 1878-1914? [36]

3. Wales and England and the First World War, 1914-1918.

- (a) Explain why Asquith's contribution was important during the First World War. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the war on the Western Front mainly responsible for British victory in the First World War? [36]
