Answer one question.

1. The nature of autocratic rule and European relations, 1815-1848.

- (a) Explain why relations between the Great Powers had deteriorated by the early 1820s. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the Vienna settlement mainly responsible for maintaining peace in the period 1815-1848? [36]

2. Italian unification, 1815-1871.

- (a) Explain why Italians looked to Pope Pius IX as a national leader in the 1840s. [24]
- (b) To what extent was Napoleon III mainly responsible for the unification of Italy between 1815-1871? [36]

3. German unification, 1815-1871.

- (a) Explain why the Zollverein was important in the process of German unification. [24]
- (b) To what extent was Bismarck mainly responsible for bringing about German unification in the period 1815-1871? [36]
