#### ASPECTS OF THE HISTORY OF EUROPE, c. 1878-1980

#### Answer one question.

Candidates in their responses to the interpretation question should consider the validity of the interpretation using their knowledge of the period and other possible interpretations. Candidates should also consider the factors which may have influenced the way in which the interpretation has been formed – such as the type of historian/author, the evidence available to the historian/author and the date of the publication.

### 1. Revolution in Russia, civil war and the rule of Stalin, 1917-1941.

'Stalin's economic policy was a great feat of social engineering which laid the foundations of a rich economy for the Soviet Union.'

How valid is this interpretation of Stalin's rule of the Soviet Union? [80]

#### 2. Fascist Italy, 1922-1939.

'Mussolini was a shallow opportunist and political manipulator whose whole regime was nothing more than a propaganda show.'

How valid is this interpretation of the impact of Fascist rule upon Italian society between 1922-1939? [80]

### 3. Nazi Germany, 1933-1939.

'Hitler was complete Master in the Third Reich. The point cannot be stressed too strongly.'
