1. Wales and England in transition, c.1880-1929

- (a) Explain why there was a need to reform living and working conditions in the late nineteenth century. [24]
- (b) To what extent were the reforms made by the Liberal Government of 1906-1914 the most important development in Wales and England between 1880-1929? [36]

2. British foreign policy, c.1902-1939

- (a) Explain why Britain signed an alliance with Japan in 1902. [24]
- (b) To what extent was fear of Germany the most influential factor in British foreign policy between 1902-1939? [36]

3. Party politics, c.1900-1940

- (a) Explain why the Coalition government ended in 1922. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the rise of the Labour Party the most important development in party politics between 1900-1940? [36]
