1. Social Reform c. 1880-1980

To what extent were the reforms of the Liberal government of 1906-1914 the most significant achievement in social reform, 1880-1980? [40]

2. Britain and Europe, c. 1880-1980

‘The fear of Russia was the main influence on British foreign policy 1880-1980.’ Discuss. [40]
