SECTION A

Answer one question.

1. Crown, Council and Parliament in the reign of Elizabeth, 1558-1603

2. Mary Stuart and England's relations with the Catholic Powers, 1568-1588

'The brutal suppression of Catholics was the main cause of conflict between England and the Catholic powers, 1568-1588.' Discuss. [40]

SECTION B

Answer one question.

1. Poverty, vagrancy and the poor in Wales and England, 1483-1603

'Attitudes to poverty and vagrancy were mainly influenced by religious changes in the period 1483-1603.' Discuss. [40]

2. Tudor foreign policy, 1483-1603

'Tudor foreign policy was mainly determined by economic considerations in this period.' Discuss. [40]
