- 2 Religious Reformation and change, c. 1529-1570
- (a) EXPLAIN WHY Protestantism was established during the reign of Edward VI. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the Elizabethan Church Settlement the MOST IMPORTANT of the religious changes in the period 1529-1570? [36]
- 3 Protest, Disorder and Rebellion, c. 1529-1569
- (a) EXPLAIN WHY the monarchy felt threatened by the Pilgrimage of Grace. [24]
- (b) To what extent was poverty MAINLY RESPONSIBLE for causing the rebellions in the period 1529-1569? [36]

- 4 Social and economic change in Wales and England, c. 1525-1588
- (a) EXPLAIN WHY enclosures became widespread in this period. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the growth of towns the MOST SIGNIFICANT development in the society and economy of Wales and England in the period 1525-1588? [36]
