SECTION A

Answer one question.

1. Depression and austerity, c. 1929-1951

2. Changes in Wales, c. 1945-1980

To what extent was the changing nature of work and employment the most important development in Wales 1945-1980? [40]

SECTION B

Answer one question.

1. Social Reform, c. 1880-1980

To what extent was social reform mainly promoted to protect Britain's economic interests in the period 1880-1980? [40]

2. Britain and Europe, c. 1880-1980

'British foreign policy from 1880-1980 was mainly characterised by conflict rather than cooperation.' Discuss. [40]
