- 1. International relations, c. 1878-1914
  - (a) **Explain why** there were tensions in the Balkans before 1914. [24]
  - (b) To what extent was Germany the **main threat** to international relations in the period 1878-1914? [36]
- 2. Germany, c. 1878-1919
  - (a) **Explain why** the German economy grew in the period 1878-1914. [24]
  - (b) To what extent did defeat in the First World War have the **most significant impact** on Germany between 1878-1919? [36]
- 3. Italy, c. 1918-1944
  - (a) Explain why Mussolini fell from power in 1943. [24]
  - (b) To what extent did Fascist social policy have the **greatest impact** on the Italian people between 1922-1944? [36]
- 4. The Communist Revolution in Russia, c. 1917-1941
  - (a) **Explain why** the Bolsheviks introduced War Communism in 1918. [24]
  - (b) Was the New Economic Policy the **most significant feature** of the Communist Revolution in Russia in the period 1917-1941? [36]
