'The most important cause of poverty and vagrancy in the period 1483-1603 was the dissolution of the monasteries.' Discuss. [40]

2. Tudor foreign policy, 1483-1603

'The most significant influence on Tudor foreign policy throughout the period 1483-1603 was the need to defend and protect the kingdom.' Discuss. [40]
