2. Martin Luther and the German Reformation, c. 1517-1555

- (a) **Explain why** Luther criticised the Catholic Church. [24]
- (b) To what extent was economic hardship **mainly responsible** for the development of the German Reformation, 1517-1555? [36]

3. France, 1515-1547

- (a) **Explain why** Francis I reformed the government of France in the period 1515-1547. [24]
- (b) How far did war with the Hapsburgs have the **most significant impact** on France in the period 1515-1547? [36]

4. Spain in the reign of Charles V, c. 1516-1556

- (a) **Explain why** Charles V took on the role of defending Christendom. [24]
- (b) Was the conquest and settlement of the New World the **most significant development** for Spain in the period 1516-1556? [36]
