In the space below justify your design, explaining how and why the objects in your design are used. Continue on page 12 if necessary. (17 marks)

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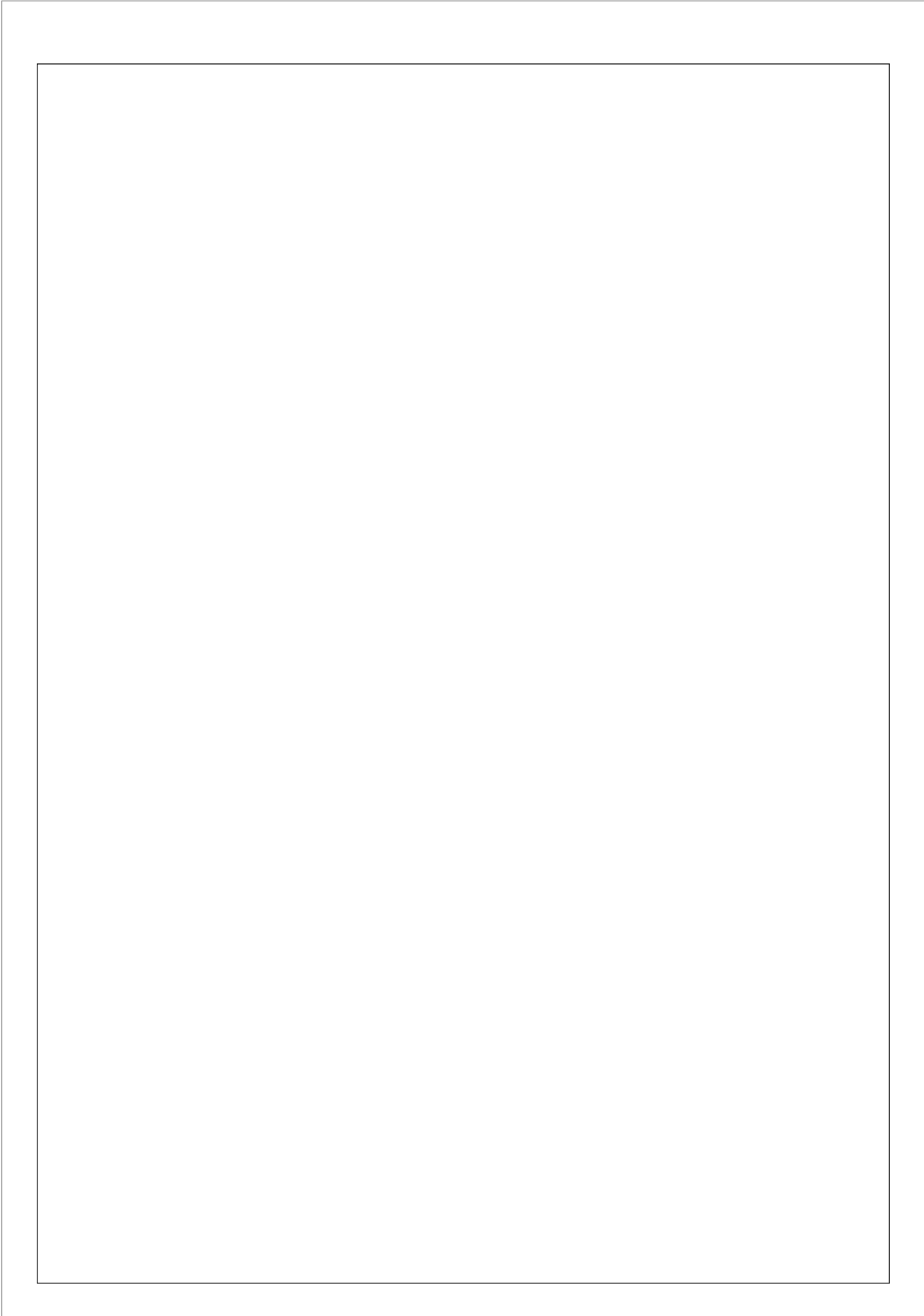
