You are going to work on a database of paint stocks.

The database has the field names: Code, Finish, Base, Colour, Litres, Stock, Cost and Value

- 1 Start your database package and import the file **FDBA5TIN.CSV** 1.1.1
 Make sure that the field names above are used in your database.
- 2 Add the record: 1.2.1

Code	Finish	Base	Colour	Litres	Stock	Cost	Value
CRWM-10	Matt	Water	White	10	100	10	1000

- 3 The size in Litres for Stock Code *CRBE-05* was entered incorrectly. 2.1.1
 Change the *Litres* for Code *CRBE-05* (*Eggshell Blue*) from 5 to **10**
 Change the *Code* from *CRBE-05* to **CRBE-10** for this record.
- 4 The record with the Code *CRGE-05* (*Eggshell Green*) is to be transferred to our city shop, so needs to be deleted. 2.2.1

Delete the record for Code *CRGE-05*

You need to produce a list of white water based paints in stock.

- 5 Find all the **Water** based paints which are **White** 3.1.1
 Sort by *Code* in ascending order. 3.2.2
 Show all the fields. 3.2.3
 4.1.1
- 6 Produce a report with the heading **Water Based Paints** and which lists only the data you have extracted and sorted in step 5. 4.1.1
- 7 Save this report with a new filename and print it. 5.1.1

You need to produce a report listing oil-based paints where levels of stock are low.

- 8 From all the data, select all stock items where the *base* is *Oil* and the *Stock* is **less than 300** 3.2.1
 Show only the fields *Code*, *Finish*, *Colour*, *Litres* and *Stock*. 3.2.3
 4.1.1
- 9 Produce a report with the heading **Low Stock Items** which lists only the data you have extracted in step 8. Make sure that all required data is shown in full. 4.1.1
- 10 Save this report with a new filename and print it. 5.1.1

- 3 Sales figures for Central America need to be revised. 2.1.1
 Replace sales for *Samsung* in Central America with **62500**
- 4 The sales figures for Caribbean are included with Central America. 2.2.1
 Delete the record for *Caribbean*
- You need to produce a list of selected *Nokia* sales.
- 5 Find all the records where *Nokia* is **greater than 70,000** and **less than 140,000** 3.2.1
 3.1.1
 3.2.3
 Sort by *Continent* in ascending order and then by *Region* in ascending order.
 Show all the fields.
- 6 Produce a report with the heading **High Sales Regions** and which lists only the data you have extracted and sorted in step 5. 4.1.1
- 7 Save this report with a new filename and print it. 5.1.1
- You need to produce a report of total sales for all the world except America.
- 8 From all the sales data select all regions **except** those where the continent is **America** 3.2.2
 Show all the fields.
- 9 Produce a report with the heading **Rest of the World** which lists only the data you have extracted in step 8. Make sure that all required data is shown in full. 4.1.1
- 10 Save this report with a new filename and print it. 5.1.1
