Identify characteristics of surviving ethnic sports in the UK.

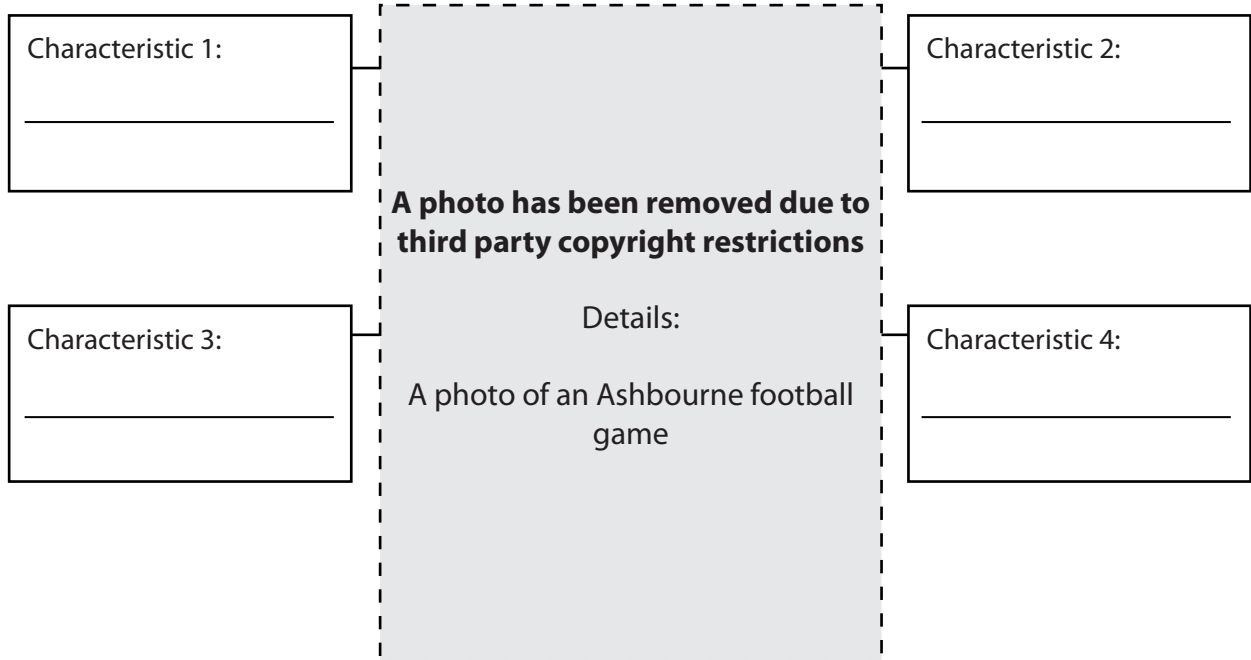
