## **Understanding Edexcel AEA Grade Boundaries**

This document shows the grade boundaries for Advanced Extension Award qualifications.

Advanced Extension Awards are graded Merit or Distinction. If you don't get enough raw marks to achieve a Merit, you will be graded U which means 'Unclassified'.

## **Definition of terms**

A grade boundary is the minimum mark at which a particular grade can be achieved. For example, if the grade boundary for a Merit is 50 marks, then 50 is the minimum mark at which a Merit can be achieved. A mark of 49 would therefore be Unclassified.

A raw mark is the actual mark awarded by the examiner for an assessment. Raw mark scores can be downloaded by Exams Officers from Edexcel Online.
