1 Read this passage and answer parts (a) and (b) which follow.

'The prophet Amos believed that he had a call from God to go and preach to the people of Israel. One of the themes of his preaching was to challenge the people's view of their future. The people thought that their future would be a good time for them, but Amos had very different views.'

- (a) Outline what the book of Amos suggests the people thought that the future would be like, and why they thought it would be like this. (10 marks)
- (b) Outline what the book of Amos suggests that Amos thought the future of the people would be like, and why he thought it would be like this. (10 marks)
- 2 (a) Both Samuel and Amos are described as prophets. Explain the characteristics of prophets which are found in stories about Samuel **and** in the book of Amos. (15 marks)
 - (b) Outline the characteristics of a prophet which are found in the traditions about Elijah, and assess the claim that calling Samuel, Elijah and Amos 'prophets' is misleading because they have nothing in common.

- 3 (a) Examine the concept of Covenant found in the material which you have studied about Abraham. (15 marks)
 - (b) (i) Outline the concept of Covenant found in the material which you have studied about Moses.
 - (ii) Assess the claim that the idea of Covenant is better illustrated by the traditions about Abraham than by those about Moses. (25 marks)
