- 3 (a)** Explain the main differences between true and false prophecy with particular reference to the confrontation between Amos and Amaziah. [30]
- (b)** Critically evaluate the claim that personal suffering was central to the life and ministry of a true prophet. [20]
- 4** “Cyrus was chosen by Yahweh to liberate the exiles”.
- (a)** With reference to this statement, analyse the message of hope given to the exiles by Second Isaiah. [30]
- (b)** Critically assess the view that Second Isaiah’s message of hope has no relevance for the modern reader. [20]
