17. (a)

- (i) Examine **either** the teachings of Jesus, in Luke's Gospel, concerning wealth and outcasts **or** examine the meaning of the sayings 'I am the bread of life' and 'I am the true vine' in the Fourth Gospel. (28 marks)
- (ii) With regard to your answer in (a), consider why these teachings/sayings were so controversial at that time. (12 marks)

- (i) What can be learned about the ministry of Jesus from **either** the calming of the storm and the healing of the bleeding woman (Luke's Gospel) **or** the turning of water into wine and the healing of the Official's son (Fourth Gospel)? (28 marks)
 - (ii) To what extent were the miracles an important aspect of Jesus' ministry? (12 marks)

- (i) **Either** examine the teaching of Jesus, in Luke's Gospel, concerning the Sabbath **or**, with examine the part played by women in the Fourth Gospel. (28 marks)
- (ii) To what extent did Jesus' teaching on the Sabbath **or** his treatment of women differ from the practices of Judaism at that time? (12 marks)

- (i) Examine the main features of Jesus' teaching concerning the nature and demands of discipleship. (28 marks)
- (ii) Why were John the Baptist and the Disciples so important to the ministry of Jesus? (12 marks)
