Alternative A The Early Church

Answer two questions.

- 1 How significant was baptism in Paul's theology?
- 2 'The First and Last Adam theology is the key to understanding Romans.' Discuss.
- 3 'The teachings in Ephesians 1-4 were for all churches, not just for Ephesus.' Discuss.
- 4 'The details in the text of Galatians 2 are historically accurate.' Discuss.

Alternative B The Gospels

Answer two questions.

- 5 'Jesus taught in parables so that no one would understand him.' Discuss.
- 6 'The Gospel writers meant to present Jesus as a faith healer rather than a miracle worker.' Discuss.
- 7 'Jesus did not oppose the law.' Discuss.
- 8 'The teachings of Jesus on the Kingdom of God were all about future judgement.' Discuss.
