Discuss. [17] 2 (a) Describe the differences between the covenants G-d made with Adam and with Abraham. [33] (b) 'The covenant with Adam was more important than the covenants with Abraham.' Discuss. [17] 3 (a) Describe the main differences between the covenants G-d made with Moses and with Jeremiah. [33] (b) To what extent was the covenant G-d made with Jeremiah a new covenant? [17]

(a) Explain the importance of the roles of the sailors and the Ninevites in the book of Jonah.

- **6 (a)** Explain why some readers might doubt the historical accuracy of the books of Jonah and Job. [33]
