- 1 (a) Explain the differences and similarities between anicca and anatta. [25] **(b)** 'The Buddhist concept of anatta does not make sense.' Discuss. [10] 2 (a) Explain the importance of the five khandas in Buddhist thought. [25] (b) To what extent can it be argued that the five khandas are the most important concept in Buddhist thought? [10] 3 (a) Explain the bodhisattva path in Mahayana Buddhism. [25] **(b)** 'Everybody should aim to become a bodhisattva.' Discuss. [10] (a) Explain the importance of the four signs in the traditional accounts of the life of the Buddha.
  - Buddha had never seen death or suffering before he left the palace.' Discuss. [10]
