#### Information for OCR centres transferring to **new specifications for first teaching in September 2008**



- Number of units required to achieve GCE A level Religious Studies is to be reduced from six to four
- All coursework to be removed from Religious Studies
- Stretch and Challenge style questions to be introduced into A2 assessment
- Synoptic content to be covered at A2
