3.	(a)	Explain what is meant by liturgical worship.	[30]
	(b)	'Liturgical worship is the only type of worship that is based on biblical practice.' Assess this claim.	[15]
4.	(a)	Explain why some Christians do not observe Christmas and Easter.	[30]
	(b)	'It is wrong for Christians not to observe Christian festivals.' Assess this view.	[15]
