The annual Health Survey for England revealed that a lack of physical activity has become a serious health issue as obesity levels are rising quickly.

In 2008 a total of 15,102 adults and 7,521 children were given questionnaires.

The research gathered **quantitative date**, collecting information about physical activity. Because of the limitations of questionnaires, such as respondents having difficulty remembering their activities or just guessing, some respondents were asked to wear measuring devices so that the accuracy of answers could be checked against the actual amount of exercise taken.
