**The British Crime Survey**

The police gather detailed **official statistics** about crimes that have been recorded. They are an accurate record of the crime that the police decide to make a note of. However, they do not take into account crimes that have not been recorded or ones that have not been reported to the Police.

The British Crime Survey is intended to discover more about the crimes that the police do not know about or record. It asks people living in households in England and Wales about their experiences of crime using a **structured interview**. 51,000 people aged 16 and over are interviewed face to face. Over 200 professional interviewers are trained to conduct the survey.
