### E-survey methodology

Electronic techniques are being increasingly used in social research. These are techniques where a computer is involved in the process of data collection. Questionnaires can be e-mail based or Web-based. Both methods can however lead to problems with the representativeness of the sample and the lack of control over who is actually completing the survey.

Electronic survey techniques have the advantage of being cheap to create, having faster response times and good response rates from large samples of people. They can be useful for collecting sensitive information and are used in the British Crime Survey for questions about domestic violence when respondents may not wish to speak to an interviewer.
