All answers must be recorded in the answer books provided. **Do not write any answers on these question sheets.**

I. EXAM AND BREAK TIMES

The exam is four (4) hours long. The exam will begin promptly at 9:00 am and will end at exactly 1:00 pm. You must stop writing at **1:00 pm** and immediately turn in your used and any unused answer books to the invigilator then leave the exam room.

During the exam, you are only permitted to leave the room to use the washroom facilities. Only one candidate may leave the room at any given time. Before leaving the exam room, you must leave the exam questions turned face down along with your closed answer books at your seat during the entire break.

II. WRITING THE EXAM

YOU MUST RECORD ALL QUESTION NUMBERS YOU SELECTED TO ANSWER ON THE COVER OF YOUR FIRST ANSWER BOOK ONLY. You must also indicate the number of answer books you used in the space provided on the top right corner of your answer book.

1. Questions are worth 10 marks each. Answer format for each question will be either:
 - **Essay:** Questions requiring essay format answers will be labelled with the word '**Essay**'. You must answer essay questions using complete sentences and paragraphs.
 - **Short Answer:** Questions requiring only short answers will be labelled with the words '**Short Answer**'. Short answers may include point form statements.
2. Select and answer **only four (4) of the seven (7)** questions [for 40 marks]
3. If you begin to answer a question and then decide to exclude it, you must clearly indicate this by crossing out the answer entirely.
4. If you answer more than four (4) questions, the Board of Examiners will accept and mark only your first four (4) answers. All subsequent answers will be voided.
5. The total marks for the sit-down exam is 40 marks. You must achieve a total of 60% or higher to pass the exam.
