20	Candidates should discuss some or all of the following checks, providing explanations on how to carry out the check and what information this provides on the health of the animal: • Weighing the animals • Measuring the volume of food / water intake • Checking temperature with a digital or mercury thermometer • Checking pulse rate in BPM • Measuring respiration rate • Checking capillary refill time • Carrying out faecal egg counts • Carrying out blood tests • Limited discussion of physical health checks. Candidates may explain how to restrain the animal for each procedure. Candidates may make reference to the importance of PPE and minimising the spread of the disease.	8
