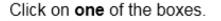
How can I see the drop down menus in the test?

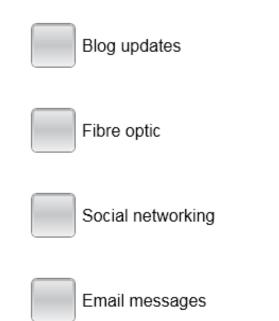


