### QUESTION 1

You are talking to a friend about your holidays.

- Say that you are going to the beach for two weeks.
- Say that you are going to your grandparents' place.
- Say that you like swimming.
- Ask your friend if she/he wants to come with you.

### QUESTION 2

You are Alex Martin, an exchange student, talking to your host family.

- Introduce yourself and spell your surname: M-A-R-T-I-N.
- Say that you have a gift for them.
- Ask your host family what time they have breakfast.
- Say that you need to go to the bank.

### QUESTION 3

At a travel agency.

- Say that you would like to go to Bordeaux by plane.
- Ask if there are flights next Thursday.
- Say that you prefer to travel in the evening.
- Ask the agent if she/he can recommend a good hotel.

### QUESTION 4

You stop at a service station.

- Ask the attendant to check the oil and water.
- Say that you have lost your map.
- Ask what is the nearest town.
- Ask how far it is from here.

### QUESTION 5

You are having dinner with friends.

- Apologise for being late.
- Say that there was an accident in the métro.
- Tell them you went to the cinema last night.
- Suggest that you all go to the country this weekend.
