- Say that you missed the 10 o'clock train to Strasbourg.
- Ask when the next train will arrive there.
- Express concern because you will be late.
- Explain why you are concerned.

Question 4 (7 marks)

You are talking to a new class friend.

- Say that you do not always have much time.
- Identify two of your favourite leisure activities.
- Say which one you prefer and why.
- Suggest that he/she comes with you on Saturday.
- Make a time and place to meet.
