Evaluate this statement with reference to a major study of ONE environmental issue.

OPTION 2. DEVELOPMENT GEOGRAPHY

EITHER

3. 'The nature and spatial distribution of development are uneven across the globe.'

Analyse this statement with reference to sample studies.

OR

4. Evaluate the development issues that affect peoples' quality of life.

OPTION 3. POLITICAL GEOGRAPHY

EITHER

5. Using sample studies, describe and account for the geographical impacts of political tensions and conflicts.

OR

6. 'The nature and causes of political tensions and conflicts are different at a variety of scales.'
