DIRECTIONS TO TEACHER/EXAMINER AND CANDIDATES

- Candidates should attempt THREE questions.
- Candidates are not allowed to write anything down during this examination, nor to ask the Teacher/Examiner for help with German expressions.
- Candidates will be given 10 minutes' preparation time.

- The Teacher/Examiner will ask each question in turn and the candidate will respond in GERMAN. Each response should last for about 1 minute.

The questions will then be put to you by the Teacher/Examiner.

You must answer in GERMAN. You should spend approximately ONE minute on each answer. Responses of less than one minute will be penalized. Anything said after TWO minutes will be disregarded by the examiners.

Each question is of equal value. Your answers will be recorded on cassette.

Attempt THREE questions.

- 1. Ein Computer zu Hause ist wichtiger als ein Fernseher. Was meinen Sie dazu?
- 2. Das Leben wird immer schwieriger für alte Leute. Sind Sie dieser Meinung?
- **3.** Frauen gehören ins Haus und sollen sich nur um Kinder und Haushalt kümmern. Was meinen Sie?
- **4.** Als Privatmenschen tun wir nicht genug, um die Umwelt zu schützen.
- 5. Ist Australien Ihrer Meinung nach einer Reise wert?
