DIRECTIONS TO TEACHER/EXAMINER AND CANDIDATES

- Candidates should attempt **THREE** questions.
- Candidates are **NOT** allowed to write anything during this examination, nor to ask the Teacher/Examiner for help with German expressions.
- Candidates will be given 10 minutes' preparation time.

- The Teacher/Examiner will ask each question in turn and the candidate will respond in **GERMAN**. Each response should last for about 1 minute.

The questions will then be put to you by the Teacher/Examiner.

You must answer in GERMAN. You should spend approximately ONE minute on each answer. Responses of less than one minute will be penalised. Anything said after TWO minutes will be disregarded by the examiners.

Each question is of equal value. Your answers will be recorded on cassette.

Attempt THREE questions.

1. Was halten Sie von dem „Generationskonflikt“?
2. Möchten Sie als Austauschschüler/-schülerin im Ausland leben? Warum/warum nicht?
3. Die Kinder von heute verbringen zu viel Zeit vor dem Fernseher. Was meinen Sie?
4. Sollte man mit dem eigenen Auto fahren oder lieber mit öffentlichen Verkehrsmitteln?
5. Arbeitslosigkeit ist das größte Problem der 90er Jahre. Was meinen Sie?
