Candidates are to respond in GERMAN to the Teacher/Examiner's statements or questions according to the outlines given in English. Candidates are expected to give detailed responses where required.

Candidates should attempt ALL FIVE Situations.

Intervals of more than approximately 15 seconds between Situations are NOT permitted.

SITUATION 1 New boy/girlfriend

Examiner Erzähl mir von deinem neuen Freund/deiner neuen Freundin.

CANDIDATE Mention the name of your new friend. Say where and when you met.

EXAMINER Wie sieht er/sie denn aus?

CANDIDATE Describe your new friend's appearance. Give THREE details.

EXAMINER Ist er/sie nett?

CANDIDATE Explain why you like him/her. Give TWO details.

EXAMINER Siehst du ihn/sie dieses Wochenende wieder?

CANDIDATE Say that you and your friend will meet this weekend. Say what you are planning

to do.

SITUATION 2 The lost bicycle

EXAMINER Wer ist da?

CANDIDATE Apologise to your parent for getting home so late. Say you are late because your

bike was stolen.

EXAMINER Wo warst du denn die ganze Zeit?

CANDIDATE Say where you were and what you were doing there.

EXAMINER Wie bist du denn nach Hause gekommen?

CANDIDATE Explain how you got home without your bike.

EXAMINER Was wirst du jetzt machen?

CANDIDATE Say what you plan to do to find your bike.

SITUATION 3 Future study plans

EXAMINER Warum möchten Sie in Deutschland studieren?

CANDIDATE Give TWO reasons why you want to study in Germany.

EXAMINER Wo möchten Sie studieren?

CANDIDATE Say where you would like to study and why.

EXAMINER Was für Unterkunft möchten Sie?

CANDIDATE Describe the sort of accommodation you would like. Give TWO reasons.

EXAMINER Und wann können Sie unser Angebot annehmen?

CANDIDATE Say when you would like to start your studies and why that time suits you.

SITUATION 4 Helping your elderly neighbour

EXAMINER Was hast du gestern gemacht?

CANDIDATE Say that you helped your elderly neighbour. Say what you did for him/her.

Give details.

EXAMINER Hat es dir gefallen?

CANDIDATE Say that the work was terrible and explain what went wrong.

EXAMINER Hast du wenigstens Geld dafür bekommen?

CANDIDATE Say how much money you received for the work and what you plan to do with it.

EXAMINER Würdest du wieder für diese Person arbeiten?

CANDIDATE Say why you would/would not work for your neighbour again.

SITUATION 5 Telling a tourist about your area

EXAMINER Entschuldigung. Sprechen Sie Deutsch? Können Sie mir helfen?

CANDIDATE Tell the person that you speak German and ask how you can help.

EXAMINER Ich möchte drei Tage hier bleiben. Was kann man hier sehen?

CANDIDATE Mention THREE sites worth seeing in your area. Give details.

EXAMINER Und was kann man hier machen?

CANDIDATE Mention TWO things to do in your area. Give details.

EXAMINER Sie sprechen aber sehr gut Deutsch. Waren Sie schon einmal in Deutschland?

CANDIDATE Say that you have been in Germany. Say where you stayed and for how long.
