SECTION I—TRAVELLER ABROAD

Situations 1–5 are COMPULSORY.

Respond to the following in **INDONESIAN**.

You are **NOT** required to produce a dialogue.

SITUATION 1. At the Airport

- State that your luggage is lost.
- Complain that you have been waiting for an hour and a half.
- Describe your luggage and say that it has not yet arrived.
- Suggest that they telephone you if it is found.
- Give the name and telephone number of the hotel where you are staying.

SITUATION 2. At the Hotel

- Greet the receptionist and remark on the beautiful view.
- Explain that you have just arrived and are seeking luxurious accommodation.
- Insist that air-conditioning is included.
- Ask if there are vacancies for this week.
- Say that you would like to stay for four nights.

SITUATION 3. Calling Room Service

- Say good morning and ask if that is room service.
- Say that you are staying in room 647.
- Order two plates of fresh fruit and two cold drinks.
- Agree that your room is very comfortable, but say that you have run out of soap.
- Ask if they could bring some to your room as soon as possible.

SITUATION 4. At the Tours Desk

- Say that you want to see some Balinese dancing.
- Ask what is on this evening.
- Agree that you will go to Peliatan to watch the Barong performance.
- Repeat that it costs Rp18 000 each, including dinner.
- Ask if you are allowed to take photographs.

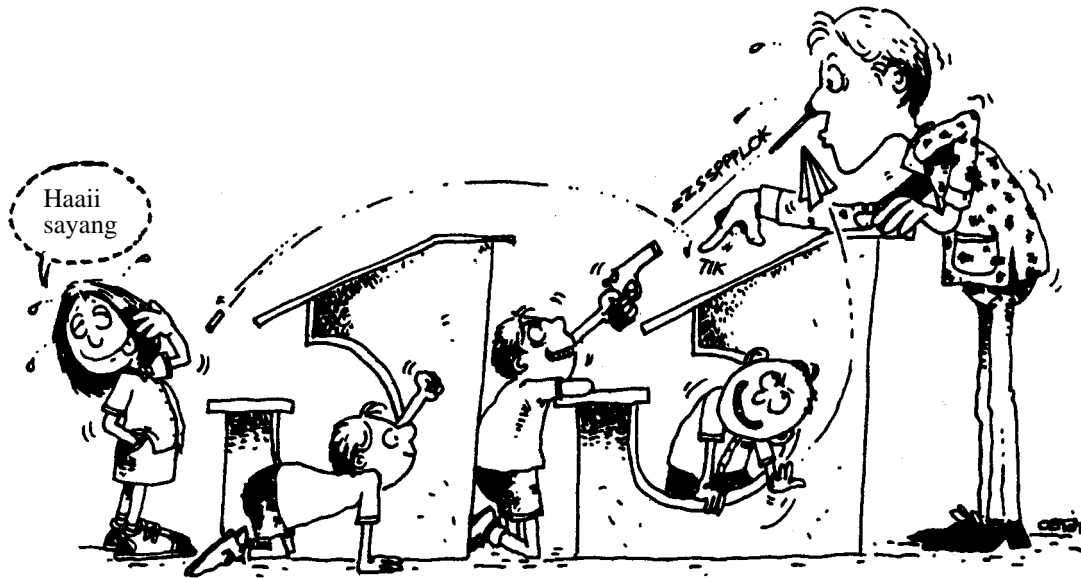
SITUATION 5. At the Railway Station

- Ask about departure times for Surabaya today.
- Repeat that there is a fast train leaving at 9 a.m. and a night train departing at 11 p.m.
- Ask which train is cheaper.
- Say that you would prefer to travel at night because it will not be hot.
- Ask if you can hire a pillow so that the journey will be more comfortable.

SITUATION 1. Mau Menjadi Guru?
