SECTION I—TRAVELLER ABROAD

Situations 1–5 are COMPULSORY.

Respond to the following in **INDONESIAN**.

You are NOT required to produce a dialogue or read the English cues onto the tape.

SITUATION 1. Travelling by Bus

- Stop a passerby and ask politely where the bus stop is.
- Ask if you can catch a bus from there to the town centre.
- Repeat the information that the bus goes via Muria Street.
- Confirm that you have to get off near the intersection of Muria Street and Singa Road.

SITUATION 2. Shopping

- Say that at last you've found a pair of shoes which are big enough.
- Ask the shop assistant if you can bargain.
- Apologise and say that you did not know it was a fixed price.
- Say you don't have enough money to buy them now.
- Say you'll come back later in the afternoon when you've changed more money.

SITUATION 3. At the Telecommunications Office

- Tell the clerk that you want to make an international call to Australia.
- Ask how much it will cost per minute.
- Ask if you can pay with a credit card.
- Ask the clerk to repeat the number of the booth where you will make the call.

SITUATION 4. At the Tourist Office in Denpasar

- Explain that you are looking for information about places of interest in the area.
- Ask if there are any maps or brochures.
- State that you are interested in the culture of the Balinese people and the beautiful scenery.
- Ask if there is a tour to Kintamani tomorrow.
- Confirm that it costs Rp16.000 including lunch at the restaurant on the slopes of the volcano.

SITUATION 5. At the Garuda Counter

- Say you have a ticket for the Garuda flight to Sydney that leaves at 11.30 p.m.
- Express your astonishment that it is already full.
- Ask if there are any seats left on another flight.
- Confirm that you are now on the 12.45 a.m. flight to Melbourne.
- Thank the person for her assistance.

Choose TWO of the following situations and respond in **INDONESIAN**.

SITUATION 1
