## SECTION I—TRAVELLER ABROAD

Situations 1–5 are COMPULSORY.

Respond to the following in **INDONESIAN**.

You are **NOT** required to produce a dialogue or read the English cues onto the tape.

### **SITUATION 1 Booking accommodation**

- Say that you want to book a room for next week.
- Ask how much it is for a room with a fan.
- Say that you will be arriving early in the morning.
- Ask how far the hotel is from the airport.

### **SITUATION 2 At the airport's lost and found office**

- Say that your plane is leaving for Jakarta at 2 pm.
- Explain that you have lost a brown leather bag.
- Say where you think you left it.
- Express your fear that it has been stolen.

### **SITUATION 3 Arranging an outing**

- Ask your friend if he/she has plans for Sunday.
- Invite your friend to a craft exhibition at the National Museum.
- Arrange a time and place to meet.
- Express your hope that the museum will not be too crowded.

### **SITUATION 4 Shopping for souvenirs**

- Say that you have to buy presents for your relatives.
- Admire the quality of the woodcarvings.
- Express disappointment that the statue you saw yesterday has already been sold.
- Ask if the prices are fixed or if you can bargain.

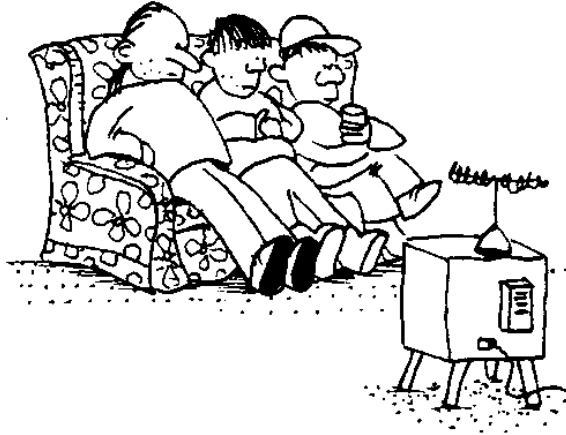
### **SITUATION 5 Visiting your Indonesian friend, Henny**

- Thank Henny for her kindness.
- Comment on the delicious food and ask if she cooked it herself.
- Say that you have never eaten *opor ayam* before.
- Ask if she could drop in to your place the day after tomorrow.

### SITUATION 6 Film dan televisi

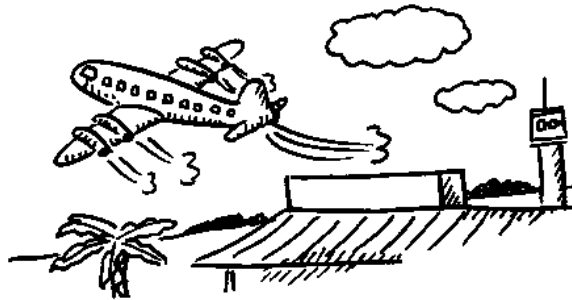


- (a) Film atau acara televisi apa yang paling Anda senangi? Mengapa?
