# **QUESTION 1** Time and Cause

### **EITHER**

(a) Does time flow or pass? Is all talk of 'passage' confused, misleading or contradictory?

OR

(b) Could there be time without change? If all change ceased, would time itself cease?

# **QUESTION 2 Self-concept**

### **EITHER**

(a) What are the implications of Dennett's story, *Where Am I?*, for traditional notions of the self?

OR

(b) John Locke suggested that personal identity is importantly linked to memory. In what sense, if any, was he right?

# **QUESTION 3** Morality, Religion and Happiness

## **EITHER**

(a) Does God's commanding me to perform some action make that act morally obligatory?

OR

(b) Is saying 'X is good' doing anything more than simply cheering for X?

# **QUESTION 4** Reality and Credibility

### **EITHER**

(a) How did Descartes reach his *Cogito* claim? Can we be certain of anything more than our own existence?

OR

(b) How does Ryle attempt to undermine the Cartesian picture of consciousness?
