QUESTION 5

Complete the conversation in SPANISH in the way outlined in brackets. (Do NOT translate the English directly into Spanish.)

At the Airport	
ADUANERO	El siguiente, por favor. Pase por la detectora y venga aquí.
USTED	(Greet the Customs Officer)
ADUANERO	Muy buenos días y bienvenido a nuestro país. ¿Por cuánto tiempo viene?
USTED	(Say that you are going to stay for a period of four months to do an intensive Spanish language course in order to improve your Spanish.)
ADUANERO	¿Dónde se alojará durante su estancia en este país?
USTED	(Say you are going to be staying at a residence at the university where you will be doing the course.)

QUESTION 5 (Continued)

ADUANERO	¿Tiene usted algo que declarar?
USTED	(Say that you have nothing to declare because you neither drink nor smoke.)
ADUANERO	Muéstreme, por favor, su pasaporte y documentación. Perdone, pero le debo decir que su visado no es válido y no puedo dejarle pasar por la aduana.
USTED	(Say that you do not understand what the problem is. Say that your travel agent organised everything for you.)
ADUANERO	Lo siento, pero su visado es sólo de turista, y no de estudiante. Tendrá que pagar otros 40 dólares más.
USTED	(Say that you do not have any money. Ask if you can pay by credit card or cheque.)
ADUANERO	Sí, por supuesto.
USTED	(Thank the Customs Officer and wish him a nice day.)
