Move the text which starts *For a flowing…* into the bottom right cell and format this as style P.

- 11 Import the image **TREE2.JPG** and place it in the right cell in row 2. Set the width to be 50 and the height to 88. Make sure all the image is visible.
- 12 Make sure that you have attached the stylesheet to this page, Save it as **RTHOME.HTM**

Print this page as it is viewed in your browser, and a copy of the HTML source.

- **13** Open the file **HOME.JPG** in a suitable application. Reduce its size to 140 pixels wide and 70 pixels high. Reduce the colour depth to 256 colours (8 bit colour) and save the file as **HOME.GIF**
- 14 Open the file **RTROOTS.HTM**. Import the image **HOME.GIF** and place it at the bottom of the page, replacing the text *Return Home*. Make this a link (in the same window) to the file **RTHOME.HTM**
